## **Leave of Absence Request Form**

Process to obtain scholarship continuation consideration

Pre-approved by the scholarship department, a student participating in a co-op, military duty, or other approved commitments may retain eligibility for specific scholarships listed below, if the student has met the first year eligibility requirements before entering said obligations. For consideration, the student must provide sufficient documentation to the scholarship department before the leave is to occur, including but not limited to the Leave of Absence Request Form. If approved, the scholarship will be posted to the students account when the student returns from their leave. An approved leave of absence will not count against the 7 consecutive semester enrollment stipulation. Students should retain copies of all documentation for their records. The student is not allowed to attend another institution during this time.
